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## SOCIETY MEETINGS

**WHEN:** The second Wednesday of each month (except December and January)

**WHERE:** The Concord Citizens Centre, 9 Wellbank Street, Concord

**TIME:** 7:30 p.m.

At each meeting, with the exception of the Annual General Meeting in August, we have a guest speaker who will talk on a variety of subject, including local or Australian history.

## MUSEUM

The Society operates a Museum at 5 Wellbank Street, Concord. This is a Social History Museum containing many, varied artefacts linked to local and Australian history and life in general in our early days. It is open 1st and 3rd Wednesday and 1st and 3rd Saturday of each month from 2:00 to 4:00 pm. We also open for special groups by prior arrangement.

## SUB-COMMITTEES

The Society supports five sub-committees. They are:

**MUSEUM:** For people whose main interest lies in our Museum. If possible they catalogue items, arrange displays, etc., and serve on roster for the days the Museum is open.

**ARCHIVES/LOCAL HISTORY:** This group is currently sorting through the many records in our possession in an endeavour to classify and catalogue them so that they can be used for research, or just for general interest.

**WALKER ESTATES:** This group's main interest is in the preservation and restoration of the "Yaralla" estate and the Thomas Walker (Rivendell) Complex. Part of this group is the **YARALLA COMMITTEE** which acts as our fund-raising arm and undertakes the organising of our Open Days at Yaralla and Rivendell.

**HERITAGE:** As well as the preservation of our heritage, this group is currently working on several projects, including researching the history behind the naming of local streets, parks, reserves, bays, etc. They are also researching material for a publication identifying the heritage of Concord.

**ORAL AND FAMILY HISTORY:** This group is currently taping oral histories and memories of the Concord area and are hoping to help people interested in researching their family history.

**Excursions:** It is hoped to be able to organise short excursions to places of historical interest from time to time.

**Volunteers:** We would be happy to accept help from people interested in historic research to carry out research for such projects as origins of street names, a study of early families, buildings, businesses, etc., in the area, or any other research pertaining to the Concord area. We would also appreciate assistance from anyone prepared to tape oral histories.

Volunteers would also be welcome in sorting and cataloguing papers, etc., in our possession and to assist in the cataloguing (and in some cases researching history of) various items in our possession at the Museum. No experience required - just time to carry out research in various libraries and archives, or at our Museum.

Help from anyone who can assist with entering/typing information onto computer (PC) or proofreading or checking typed items would also be appreciated.

We also need volunteers to act as guides for our Open Days at Yaralla and Thomas Walker (Rivendell) and to assist with Devonshire Teas and other organisational work. Help is also needed on occasional week days for tour groups visiting Yaralla.

**Membership** of the Society is open to anyone interested in the history of the Concord area. Fees are: Single, \$16.50; Single Student or Pensioner, \$8.80; Family, \$27.50; Family Pensioner, \$13.20; Group, \$27.50.
